



2021 Bike Draw CONTEST RULES

1. The Pedals & Pubs & Patios Bike Draw (the “Contest”) is offered only at Uptowne Olds in Olds, Alberta, Canada, and is sponsored by Uptowne Olds.
2. To enter, obtain an official entry ballot, complete and deposit it in the entry box at the Pedals & Pubs & Patios event, or at the Uptowne Olds Information Table at other community events. Limit of one entry per person per event. No purchase necessary.
3. **Contest begins at 12:00 pm MT on June 19, 2021 and ends at 11:59 pm on August 28, 2021.**
4. This contest is open to all residents of Alberta who are the age of the majority at the time of entry. (Minors may enter with parental approval.) Executive volunteers, agents, and representatives of Uptowne Olds and associated advertising agencies are not eligible to win. **This contest will not exclude volunteers outside the sitting Executive, nor any business employees or direct family members of any Uptowne Olds member businesses, representatives, or agencies.**
5. A random draw will take place at Olds Town Square at 12:00 pm (noon) on Saturday, August 28, 2021. The odds of winning depend on the number of entries received.
6. Attempts will be made to contact the selected entrant at the telephone number on the ballot during regular business hours for a period of 10 working days. Alternatively, if contact is not made within 24 hours, an email will also be sent requesting the selected entrant call the delegate of Uptowne to claim the Prize.
7. If a selected entrant cannot be contacted within the allotted time, Uptowne Olds reserves the right to void that entry and select another eligible entrant for the Prize in order to declare a winner.
8. The selected entrant must correctly answer a skill-testing mathematical question without mechanical or other assistance.
9. The selected entrant will be required to sign and return a Declaration of Release Form before being presented with the Prize.

10. If a selected entrant fails to sign and return the release form and/or provides an incorrect answer to the skill-testing mathematical question, Uptowne Olds reserves the right to void that entry and select another eligible entrant for the Prize.
11. By completing, signing, and returning the Declaration & Release Form, the entrant
 - a. confirms compliance with these Contest Rules
 - b. releases and forever discharges Uptowne Olds, its volunteers, members, affiliated agencies and representatives from all claims, demands, damages, actions and causes of action arising or to arise by reason of acceptance or use of the Prize, and
 - c. gives permission to Uptowne Olds, at its option, to publish or otherwise use the entrant's name, address, photograph, voice or comments without compensation in any publicity carried out by Uptowne Olds or its advertising partners.

The Prize must be accepted as awarded and no substitution, transfer or conversion will be allowed, unless at the discretion of the Uptowne Olds Executive Committee which may substitute a prize of comparable or greater value. All entries become the property of Uptowne Olds and will not be returned. Uptowne Olds assumes no responsibility for lost, invalid, delayed or misdirected entries.

All entrants release and forever discharge Uptowne Olds, its advertising and promotional partners and agencies, and their respective affiliated companies and members, and all of their respective officers, directors, volunteers and agents from all claims, demands, damages, actions or causes of action arising or to arise by reason of his/her participation in the Contest and/or the administration of the Contest.

Neither Uptowne Olds nor its representatives shall in any way bear any liability whatsoever regarding the Prize and in no event shall Uptowne Olds or its representatives be liable for any special, incidental, consequential, indirect or punitive damages arising out of or in connection with this Contest and/or the Prizes, however arising, including negligence.
15. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws in Canada. Any litigation must be commenced in the Town of Olds, Alberta.
